

On Saturday 2th April, the actual holiday/anniversary meeting was held, also in the FreemasonsHouse. Here there were over 100 brothers gathered to celebrate the 25th anniversary of lodge Janus, and the lodges on Iceland.

Lodge Camulus 50 years!



The Camulus lodge in Skövde was finally able to solemnly celebrate its 50-year existence on April 2, 2022, however 2 years late due to the pandemic.At 15:00 the gates were opened and the expectant brothers gathered at the pre-lodge for mingling together with brothers from visiting lodges from both Sweden and the lodge Uxello, Halden in Norway. Marshal Jan Hjortfors then called the brothers to enter Lunden, where scribe Tomas Monsén read out the minutes from the founding of Lodge Camulus on 4/4 1970 and from the inauguration of Lodge Camulus on 5/4 1970 at Borgmästargården Skövde. After MÄ Johan Rapp preferred a short history from the history of Lodge Camulus,celebrated RSM Niklas Larsson and called on Lodge Camulus to continue the

Then finally came the long-awaited day, when we were to celebrate Lodge Selene's 50th Anniversary.Lodge Selene was founded on March 25, 1972, but it was 50 years and one day later that we celebrated our anniversary.Gathering The day's festivities began at 3.30 pm with a gathering in the antechamber.





TjOÄ Per-Arne Meijgren drew a historical summary of the creation of Logen Selene, which at the idea stage was already started in the late 60s. The work culminated in Lodge Selene being instituted on Saturday, March 25, 1972. The

Lodge was named Selene after the Greek word for moon, which links well with the mother lodge Stella Polaris.

TjOÄ Per-Arne Meijgren highlighted 2 brothers who put in a lot of work with the Lodge to get brothers in our Lodge. Those whomentioned were OÄ Nils-Gustav Gardahl and OÄ Lars Nordblad. The next Brother admitted to our Lodge receives number 300 in the register. We have high attendance at our meetings and new brothers are coming in. We were informed that Lodge Selenevarit was represented in both Grand Lodge Sunnanland and in the Iks Grand Lodge.Head of the order RSÄÄ ROA Anders Eriksson gave a historic speech andhanded over a gift in the form of a deposit in the fund.

A peacekeeping force



The first chapter in our modern days history of druidism descends from the foundation of the first lodge in London 239 years ago. The good idea spread and the establishing of more druidlodges were created.

Not only in the country were it all started, but later in USA, Germany, Australia, New Zealand, Switzerland,

Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Iceland and Finland. A living organisation consisting of men who only have an intention to better know themselves and their brothers. A worldwide organisation to develop the idea of druidism and brotherly love.

When druids meet, they always greet each other with a brotherly handshake and show respect and happiness over meeting again. Everywhere the lodge meetings are carried through in line with traditions and thoroughly considered rituals without any objections. The elected officials prepare well in order to manage running the meeting the way brothers have been used to through years in a lifelong learning process.

Every brother may hold his own personal experiences in the process to himself. The experiences may differ. Younger brothers get tutoring and are in their full right to question the subjects with great enthusiasm in order to improve their insight.

Another may, with just as much right, choose a more simple way to look at

theoretic learning, and be happy just to participate in a friendly environment in the lodge.

The druidic education, however, no matter what, given time, shape the brothers by being together with brothers, the repetitive contents in the meetings and by new discoveries at rank advancements.

The periods as elected assistant or officer will also set its mark on a brother through a concrete learning process. There is always time for mistakes, and we can all make mistakes during a lodgemeeting.

Mistakes are accepted, however, and anyone, being an officer or assistant doing a mistake may use it as an experience in their learning process.

The World Congress

A brother tells about his first world congress. He was not allowed to any ritual meeting. In a strange country - in a small town - 500 druidic guests were gathered for a few days. The young brother never felt a stranger. Lunch with German and Danish brothers, on a busride with Swedes, Swiss and Englishmen, a drink with Americans and an evening meal with Norwegians and Australians. The experience of being together with people of different languages from all over the world made a lasting impression and became the most important lesson for this brother.
